

The new EU Construction Products Regulation - What's new and what will change for manufacturers and distributors?

The new EU Construction Products Regulation was published in the Official Journal of the EU on 18.12.2024. The new EU Construction Products Regulation entails far-reaching changes for the European construction sector. Among other things, it aims to make sustainable products the norm in the EU and promote circular business models. The Green Deal has also had a significant influence on the new Construction Products Regulation: the gradual mandatory declaration of defined environmental indicators for construction products is planned. In addition, product-inherent requirements and the concrete implementation of the digital product passport have been introduced as innovations. In this context, the regulation's provisions are being extended to new economic players, new components are being introduced and existing ones are being amended.

The workshop will address the following questions:

- Which existing requirements of the EU CPR continue to apply?
- Which existing requirements of the EU CPR have changed?
- What are the new requirements for manufacturers and distributors?
- What is the timetable for the changes to come into force?
- What new things do I need to consider when purchasing products?
- How do I have to adapt my technical documentation?
- What evidence and documents do I need to provide?

The aim of the workshop is to work out the differences between the new CPR and the "old" one and to recognise the main points of action for manufacturers and retailers. A list of priorities for implementation in companies will be drawn up based on the significance of the changes.

The target group:

The workshop is aimed at manufacturers of floor, wall and ceiling coverings as well as wholesalers with their own brands. It is designed for employees from the following areas:

- Management
- Technical management
- Development department
- Purchasing
- Quality assurance
- Evaluation and authorisation of construction products

Important: As the differences between the new and the "old" CPR are the focus of the workshop, basic knowledge of current CE labelling and its background is a prerequisite for participants.
